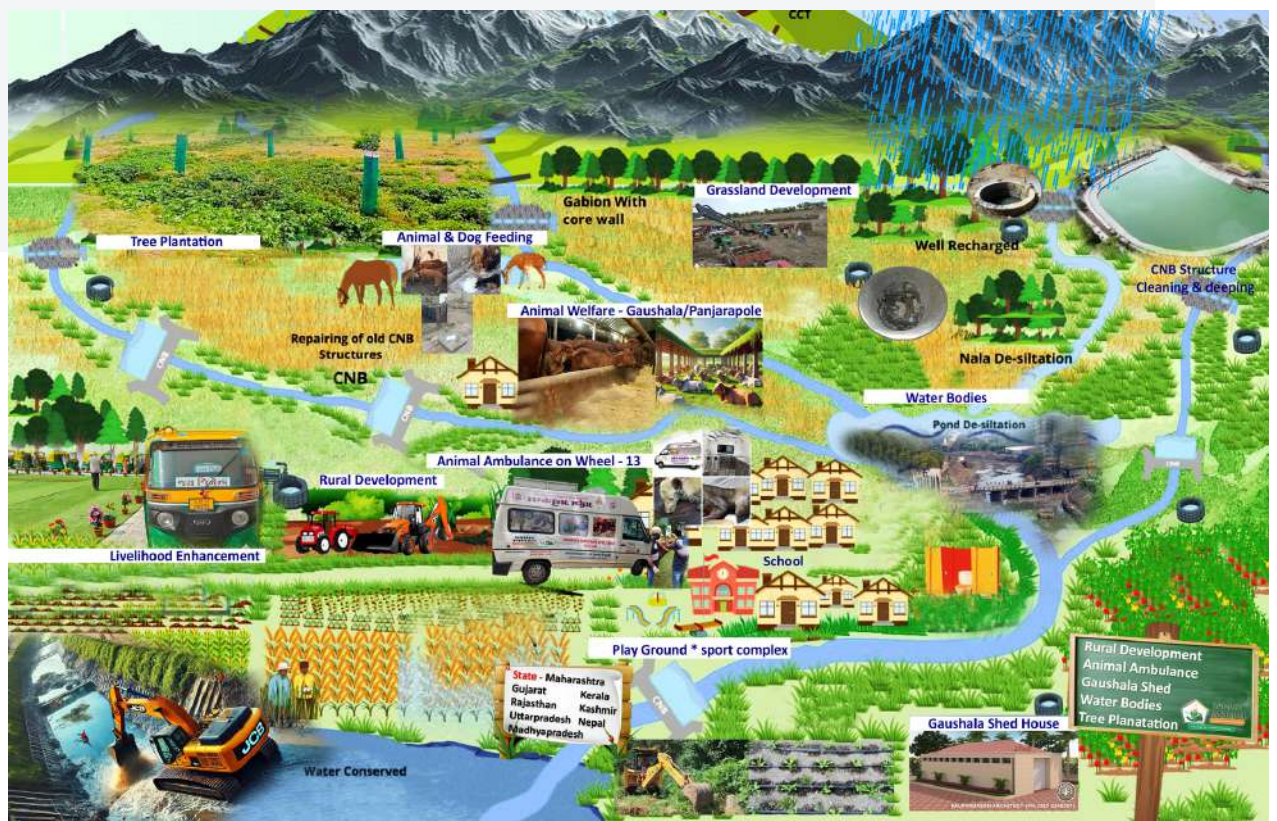

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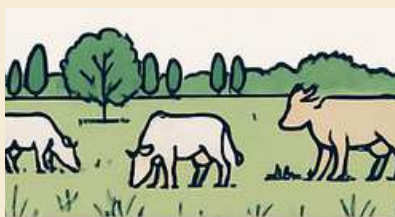

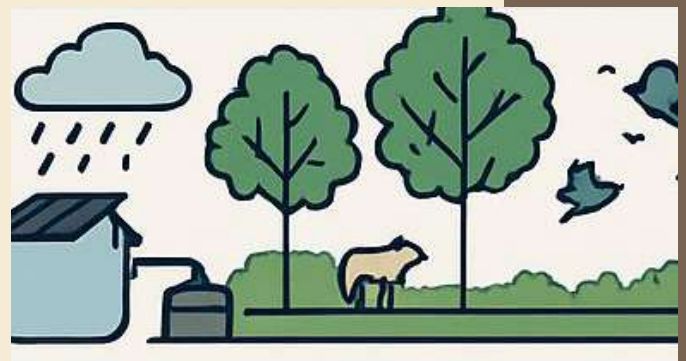

- **State-Level Coordination** – We work with Panjarapoles, Gaushalas, and state governments to streamline operations and secure subsidies.
- **Training & Guidance** – Regular workshops and training improve administrative and operational efficiency.
- **Fodder Land Development** – Dedicated Gauchar land is developed for sustainable cattle fodder



- **Rainwater Harvesting** – Systems are installed to meet water needs sustainably.
- **Tree Plantation & Bird Conservation** – Indigenous trees are planted to support birdlife and ecological balance.



- **Infrastructure Guidance** – Technical support is provided for essential facilities like sheds, water, and housing.
- **Emergency Fodder Supply** – Fodder is delivered during droughts and shortages to support affected areas.



Our objective is to ensure that every Panjarapole and Gaushala becomes self-reliant, and that every animal receives love, protection, and proper care. We are committed to strengthening this mission with the support of all stakeholders, donors, and government departments.

This order is liable to be withdrawn by the prescribed authority if it is subsequently found that the activities of the applicant are not genuine or if they are not carried out in accordance with all or any of the conditions subject to which it is granted, if it is found that the applicant has obtained the provisional registration by fraud or misrepresentation of facts or if it is found that the assessee has violated any condition prescribed in the Income Tax Act, 1961.

A public notice of the activities carried on to be carried on and the target group(s) (intended beneficiaries) shall be duly displayed at the Registered/ Designated Office of the Organisation.

i. The Trust/ Institution shall furnish a return of income every year within the time limit prescribed under the Income Tax Act, 1961.

j. Separate accounts in respect of profits and gains of business incidental to attainment of objects shall be maintained in compliance to section 11(4A) of Income Tax Act, 1961.

k. The registered office or the principal place of activity of the applicant should not be transferred outside the jurisdiction of Jurisdictional Commissioner of Income Tax except with the prior approval.

l. No asset shall be transferred without the knowledge of Jurisdictional Commissioner of Income Tax to anyone, including to any Trust/ Society/ Non Profit Company etc.

m. The registration so granted is liable to be cancelled at any point of time if the registering authority is satisfied that activities of the Trust/ Institution/ Non Profit Company are not genuine or are not being carried out in accordance with the objects of the Trust/ Institution/ Non Profit Company.
