


Our responsibility in action

Through our Vriksharopan (Tree Plantation) Initiative, we have successfully planted over 10,000+ trees across various regions, contributing to environmental sustainability, biodiversity conservation, and rural empowerment.

These are not just ambulances; they are fullyequipped mobile hospitals designed to cater to emergencies and critical care. Here's what makes Samast Mahajan's ambulances stand out:

Operation Theaters: Fully functional units to perform emergency surgeries on the go.
Anesthesia Units: Ensures painless and safe procedures for animals in critical conditions
Oxygen Cylinders & Concentrators: Life-saving equipment for animals in need of respiratory support.

Freezers for Medications: Ensures proper storage of injections and medicines for timely treatments.









In 2022, we launched our 11 Animal Hospital on Wheels, a pioneering initiative dedicated to saving the lives of animals and birds. In just a year and a half, we've provided critical care to over 50,000 animals that might have otherwise suffered and died in pain. Our ambulances are fully equipped with essential medical facilities, including an operation theatre, anaesthesia, oxygen cylinder and concentrator, refrigerator for storing injections, geyser, and fire safety equipment. When animals are found wounded or injured in accidents, they are treated on-site in our ambulances. Our team, consisting of a qualified BVSc doctor and a Livestock Inspector (LIS), performs necessary operations and

Water Bodies Rejuvenation

- •Samast mahajan also works to conserve natural resources by desilting ponds, lakes and other small water bodies in the affected villages, helping in higher water percolation.
 - •Rainwater is collected & conserved in these clean & desilted nallas and lakes.
- •In villages, we have done the Grass Land, Lakes/Veins desilted and cleaned.
- Deepened and cleaned ponds across villages, significantly increasing water storage capacity.
- Developed over —- acres of land, benefiting families who now have access to water for agriculture, livestock, and personal use
- Implemented soil conservation techniques to enhance groundwater recharge.
- Created grasslands and catchment areas around water bodies to prevent soil erosion and sustain biodiversity.




